Holiday Happenings

From markets to ice-skating, there is always something fun happening in Alpharetta. Check out some of these events happening all around the city this November and December:

- The Lighting of Avalon: A Twelve Day Celebration, Nov. 22 Dec. 3, 2020
 In place of the one-day tree lighting extravaganza, Avalon will host a 12-day celebration with different outdoor activities along the Boulevard each day, including Avalon on Ice performances, rooftop cocktail hours, carolers, pop-up concerts and more. At 7 p.m. each night during the 12-day celebration, guests will be dazzled by a spectacular firework show around Avalon's 40-foot tree. Free admission.
- <u>Avalon on Ice</u>, Nov. 22, 2020 Jan. 18, 2021
 Lace up those skates because Avalon's Rockefeller Center-inspired ice rink returns to Alpharetta.
 Hours vary by day of the week and for school holidays. Ticket admission required.
- <u>Holiday Market at Avalon</u>, Nov. 22, 2020 Jan. 3, 2021
 Take a break from the skating and browse through a curated selection of 12 local artisan makers and merchants, a one-stop shop for everyone's gifting needs with an array of handcrafted goods. Free admission to the market.
- <u>Snow In Downtown Alpharetta</u>, Dec. 4, 11 and 18, 2020
 A flurry of snow is coming to Downtown Alpharetta's Town Green from 6 7 p.m. on the first three Fridays in December. The snowy spectacle is free for the public to enjoy, along with the return of the handmade, life-size nutcrackers and beautiful winter décor lining the streets of boutique shops and restaurants.
- <u>Alpharetta Christmas Market</u>, *Dec. 5 and Dec. 12, 2020* Nearly 70 vendors will gather in Downtown Alpharetta to offer the finest Christmas gifts and products for everyone on the gift list. Enjoy live music while shopping through a variety of crafts, food, décor, jewelry and more. Free admission.
- North Point Mall Christmas Market, Dec. 18 20, 2020 The market will feature goods from unique artisans and crafters, making for one-of-a-kind holiday gifts for friends, family and loved ones. Free admission to the market.

Santa Sightings

Not only does Santa shop in Alpharetta but he stops by for a visit, too. Here are some of the most wonderful places to see Santa in Alpharetta:

- Santa at Avalon, Nov. 23 Dec. 24, 2020 (By appointment only)
 Santa will be at Avalon throughout the season taking photos in an open-air, North Pole-inspired cottage in Palmer Plaza. While visits will look a little different this year, the magic of the Santa experience will remain the same. Hours vary by day of the week. Reservation appointments are required this year.
- <u>Storytime With Santa at Avalon</u>, Every Monday, Nov. 23 Dec. 21, 2020
 Visit Avalon for Storytime with Santa. Settle into Santa's backyard (the open green space behind his cottage) for holiday stories read by the jolly man himself each Monday of the holiday season. Be sure to bundle up if its chilly as story time will take place outdoors. Ticket admission required.
- <u>Santa at North Point Mall</u>, Nov. 27 Dec. 24, 2020
 Santa and his holiday magic returns to North Point Mall this year to meet with guests in a socially distanced manner at Santa's Toy Factory. Hours vary by day of the week. Photo reservations are strongly encouraged.
