## Alpharetta Welcomes The 16<sup>th</sup> Annual Great Atlanta Shootout Basketball Tournament

Three Exciting Days of Law Enforcement Basketball Tournament Play, March 26 – 28

**ALPHARETTA, GA - (March 22, 2021)** – Law Enforcement basketball teams from all over the U.S. are set to compete in the <u>16<sup>th</sup> Annual Great Atlanta Shootout Basketball Tournament</u> in Alpharetta, Ga. on Friday, March 26 through Sunday, March 28. 35 teams will compete in three different divisions: Men's Open Division, Women's Division and 40 and Over Division. The tournament will take place at three Alpharetta sports venues: the Alpharetta Community Center, Alpharetta Recreation Center and Crabapple Government Center.

Players in the Great Atlanta Shootout are comprised of law enforcement officers, detention officers, corrections officers, firefighters, probation officers, active U.S. Armed Forces members and spouses of law enforcement officers. Some of the teams competing in the 3-day event include the New York Police Department, Orlando Police Department, New Jersey State Corrections Department, EMCMP Marines and the hometown team The DeKalb Knights (comprised of various officers from several agencies from around metro Atlanta).

"We are extremely excited to bring the Great Atlanta Shootout to City of Alpharetta this year," said Lt. C. Rorey, DeKalb County police officer and organizer of the tournament. "We chose to hold the tournament in Alpharetta because of the city's basketball facilities as well as all of the restaurants, entertainment and shopping opportunities that the players and their families can enjoy when they are off the court."

Tournament play will operate with the Men's Open Division, beginning with two pools with 10 teams in each. The top five teams from each pool after pool play will advance to bracket play. In the 40 and Over Division, there are also two pools with the top 2 teams after pool play advancing to bracket play. In the

Women's Division, there will be round robin games and then all 5 teams will be seed for bracket play. There are currently 21 teams in the Men's Open bracket, nine teams in the Men's 40 and Over bracket and five teams in the Women's bracket.

"We are thrilled to welcome the Great Atlanta Shootout to Alpharetta," said Janet Rodgers, president and CEO of the Alpharetta Convention and Visitors Bureau. "A basketball tournament of this nature in our destination creates a wonderful energy. Alpharetta will be host to many players, their families and visitors who will shop, dine, play and stay in our awesome community."
