Music Fills The Streets Of Downtown Alpharetta At The 8th Annual Wire & Wood Alpharetta Music Festival

Two-day, FREE festival with over 30 artists on six stages, Oct 8-9

ALPHARETTA, GA - (September 15, 2021) – The Wire & Wood Alpharetta Music Festival returns to Downtown Alpharetta for its eighth year on Friday and Saturday, Oct. 8 - 9 from 5 p.m. – 11 p.m. The FREE admission festival will showcase more than thirty (30) performances by singer-songwriters representing a variety of music genres on six outdoor stages throughout the Downtown Alpharetta area. This year's festival will feature headliners <u>Drew Holcomb & The Neighbors</u> and <u>Ruthie Foster</u>.
