ALPHARETTA, GA – (August 19, 2022) – Kids ages 6 to 14 years old are invited to Wills Park in Alpharetta on Sunday, September 25, 2022, to compete in the Dawson Pediatric Peach Kids Triathlon, a USA Triathlon sanctioned event.



The race divisions include Juniors, ranging 6 to 8 years old; Intermediates, ranging 9 to 11 years old; and Seniors, ranging 12 to 14 years old, giving each athlete the opportunity to compete at an attainable level. For example, a Junior will complete a 50-yard swim, while an Intermediate will complete a 100-yard swim and a Senior will complete a 200-yard swim.

Beginning at Wills Park Pool for the swim portion of the event, the triathlon will continue with biking, and conclude with the running segment through the trails at Wills Park. James Rainey of Georgia Multisports Productions said, "We love hosting this event in Alpharetta and are happy to host it at Wills Park. This is a great course, and we are thankful for the work the City of Alpharetta does to help facilitate the event and keep the athletes safe."
